Dr. Adam Eldridge, University of Westminster

The growth of Britain's night-time economy has occurred alongside changing patterns of work, family life, leisure and domesticity. This presentation examines how the **night-time economy** is possibly challenging and reconfiguring the traditional **temporal organisation** of urban lives and cities in the UK. However, while the night is routinely celebrated as good for the economy, I also question to what extent this process is causing new forms of **inclusion and exclusion** at night, and whether the night-time is indeed fundamentally re-shaping our everyday lives.
